

Kista Cricket Club's Code of Conduct

All members are expected to comply with the KCC's code of conduct as laid out below and that, by taking part in activities organised by the Club, you agree to comply with all reasonable instructions from team Captain/ Voice Captains. The purpose of this code is to establish KCC as a club where consideration is given by the members to the needs of KCC rather than just to themselves as individuals.

We are an amateur club run by volunteers with the aim of playing and promoting cricket in Kista and in Stockholm. As such, the committee's desire is to make decisions which support the Club within the Spirit of Cricket and our cricket community.

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person within the context of cricket
- Treat everyone equally and not discriminate on the grounds of age, gender, disability, race, ethnic origin, nationality, colour, parental or marital status, religious belief, class or social background, sexual preference or political belief
- Not condone, or allow to go unchallenged, any form of discrimination if witnessed
- Display high standards of behaviour
- Promote the positive aspects of cricket, team and teammates. Avoid criticising the team or players.
- Do not smoke or drink while in the ground
- Encourage all participants to learn the Laws and rules and play within them, always respecting the decisions of match officials
- Actively discourage unfair play, rule violations and arguing with match officials
- Recognise good performance not just match results
- Place the well-being and safety of children above the development of performance
- Pay your match fees on the day of the game or pay annual subscriptions
- Issues with selection, not getting chances etc should be raised to Selection Committee
- Breaches of this Code may result in the player:
 - Being required to apologise to team-mates, the opposition, and the umpire
 - Receiving a warning from the Disciplinary Committee
 - Being suspended
 - Being required to leave KCC
